

TYPICAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE VAN



Emergency Response Unit (E.R.U.)

Purpose: The E.R.U. is dispatched by the TOC Upon arrival at the incident sight the operator establishes proper traffic control and relays information to the TOC concerning lane closures, backups and estimated duration. The ERU. operator also aids police and fire personnel in clearance of debris and vehicles from the roadway.

Hours of operation: Weekdays 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and on call for emergencies.
